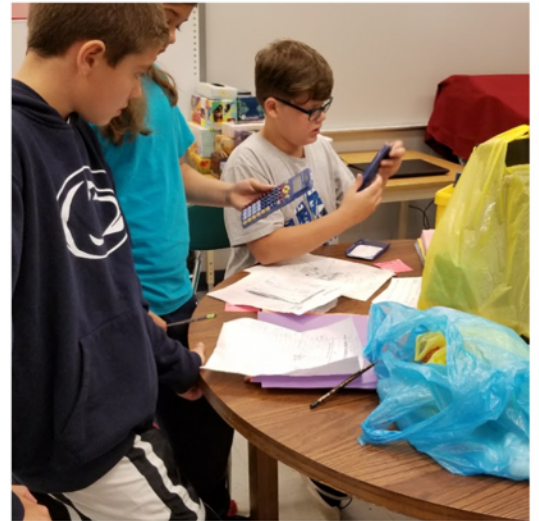
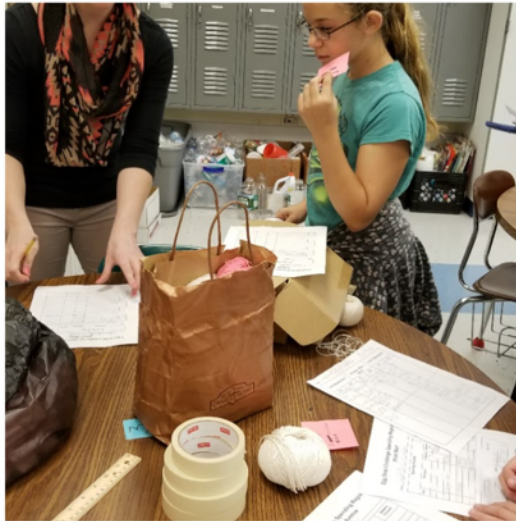
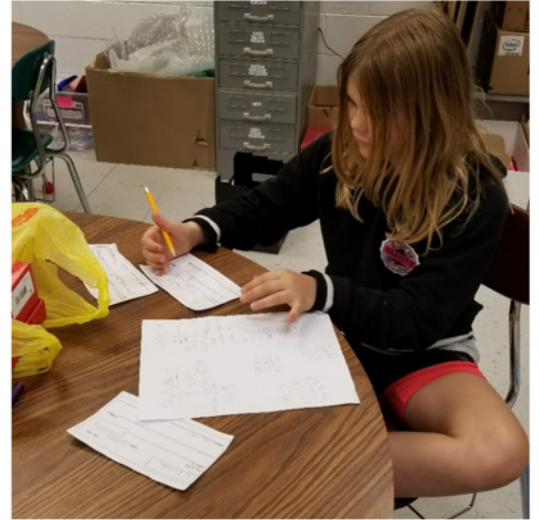




Egg Drop Purchase Day
