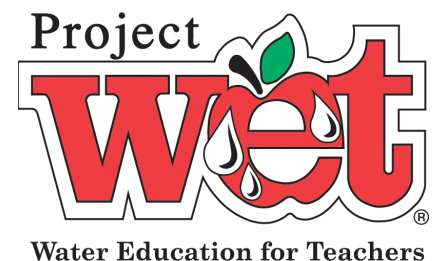
**Project WET:

We are pleased to announce that the Hamburg School has become the recipient of a New Jersey Water Education grant entitled Project WET : Make a Splash. This is our school's 1st time hosting a water festival and one of only a few schools in the state to receive funding. The Water Festival will celebrate the wonders of our water resources. The Water Festival will consist of structured learning stations where students in Grades PreK-8 will be actively engaged in hands-on water lessons and investigations throughout the day.

In addition to our learning stations, we will have a presentation from the Clean Communities Presenter – Dave Street; and participation from a host of Hamburg and Sussex County Associations. The students will be engaged throughout the day with these presentations, water experiments, a scavenger hunt, and more.

The Water Festival will be held on June 6, 2018; with a raindate of June 11, 2018.
