

Week Ahead : November 29, 2021

Good evening Hamburg School community. These are items of interest for the week of November 29, 2021.

Menu Change : November 29th will now feature mini pizza bagels for lunch.

Travel Quarantine : Hamburg School is following the <u>CDC guidelines</u> regarding travel. Unvaccinated individuals traveling outside neighboring states will need to quarantine for up to 10 days upon return. This is supported by our County Department of Health.

Dismissal Meeting : Hamburg School will be hosting an open community forum with a focus on problematic dismissal issues. Topics of discussion will include parking, pick up procedures, and alternative dismissal suggestions. This meeting is scheduled for Thursday, December 2nd at 6:30 PM via Zoom.

Sidewalk Use : As a friendly reminder, the driveway / hill leading up to the middle school area is not a sidewalk. Pedestrians must use the sidewalks in front of the gym and along Linwood when leaving the building.

After School Parking : Vehicles should not park in the restricted fire lane while waiting for students. If your child participates in an after school activity (sports, clubs or detention), please wait for them in a vacant parking spot, not the fire lane.
