

Week Ahead: January 10, 2022

Good evening Hamburg School community. These are items of interest for the week of January 10 2022.

New Marking Period: The 3rd Marking Period begins on Wednesday. This marks the academic midyear point. Student Report Cards will be available by Tuesday, January 18th.

YMCA Programs: The Sussex County YMCA has a number of programs available for families in our area. Check the January tab of the <u>Digital Backpack</u> to view the programs and respective flyers.

Potential Pivot to Remote Learning: Due to the sharp rise in COVID transmission in our region, Hamburg School's staff may become symptomatic and need to quarantine. We may experience staffing shortages on any given day. If this is the case, or our school is required to close for other public health reasons, we may pivot to remote learning on a moment's notice. Please prepare for this scenario with friends, neighbors and family members.

MLK Jr. Day: As a reminder, Sussex County Schools are closed on Monday, January 17th in observance of Martin Luther King, Jr. Day.

Morning Screening: We ask that families review the <u>Daily Health Screening</u> questions before leaving for school. If a student or staff member answers "yes" to any of the questions, they should remain home and contact the main office.

PRIDE Survey: Students in grades 6-8 have been asked to participate in an anonymous survey in mid-January. The survey data will help develop safety/bullying and drug education programs for students in New Jersey. If you would like to omit your child from participating, please return the completed <u>form</u> on the Digital Backpack.

BeforeCare: If you are interested in the possibility of a Before-School childcare program, please call Mrs. Murphy at extension 500. This may support families impacted by the cancellation of the "community bus."


PTA News
