Good evening Hamburg School community. These are items of interest for the week of January 24, 2022.

Meeting: There is a Hamburg Board of Education meeting this Tuesday at 7PM in the cafeteria.

**School Messenger**: If you are aware of a member of our school community who is <u>NOT</u> receiving the school alerts (Week Ahead messages, delayed openings, school closings, safety drill notifications), please ask them to contact the main office. School staff are unable to adjust the system if not made aware of the issue.
