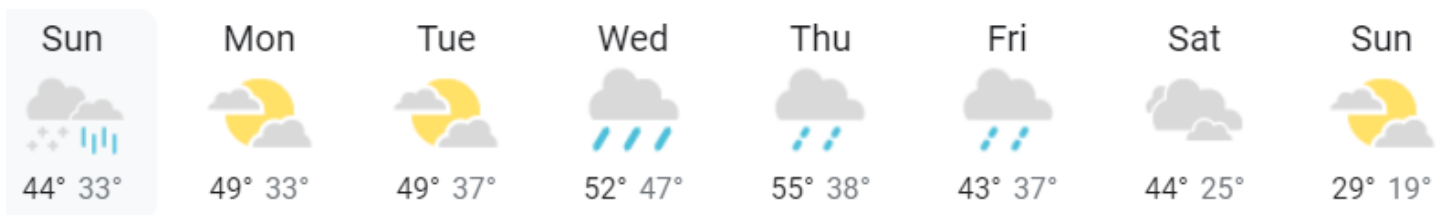
PTA News
