Picture Day : Smile! Picture Day is this Thursday, Sept. 29th. Order forms will be sent home with students tomorrow.

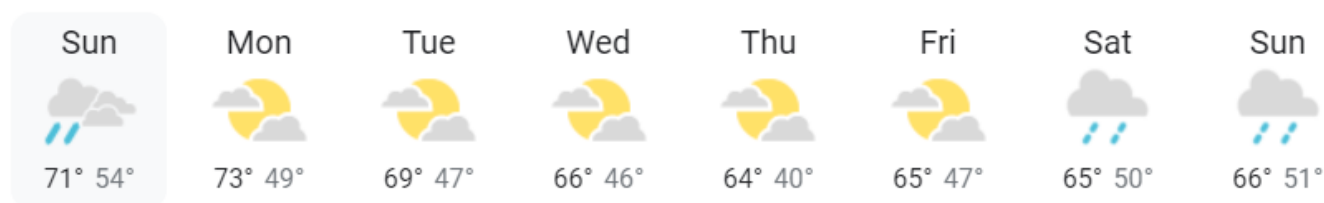
Menu : There is a change to the lunch menu for Thursday, September 29th. Students will be offered two entrees, a black bean & cheese empanada or pancake bites.
