Mr. Jinks reported that there were two (2) HIB investigations conducted between 22 November and 15 December 2017. Based on the findings of the investigation, <u>one claim</u> was determined to be unsubstantiated and <u>one claim</u> was determined to be substantiated. Due to the findings of this investigation, it was determined that the accused must undergo sensitivity and awareness training related to harassment, intimidation and bullying. Also, additional character education lessons will be taught to the students to promote positive social interactions.
