

Week Ahead: January 18, 2021

Good evening Hamburg School community. These are items of interest for the week of January 18, 2021.

Martin Luther King, Jr. Day: In observance of MLK, Jr. Day, Hamburg School is closed tomorrow, January 18th.

Third Marking Period: The third term begins Tuesday. Student's report cards will be available for review by Friday, the 22nd. Parents can access their child's grade report via the OnCourse Parent Portal. Reports cards will also be sent home in mail.

Pictures: LifeTouch Photography will be in school this Wednesday. Students seeking retakes need to bring their original packet. Mrs. Murphy has extra forms for students who have not yet had their picture taken. If needed, remote learners are invited to come to the school from 1-2.

COVID-Related Symptoms: It is imperative that all Hamburg Families continue to follow the health department's guidance. Students must stay home if they have <u>COVID-like symptoms</u>. If a student comes to school symptomatic, then any student or staff member who was in close contact will have to be quarantined for up to 14 days. An alternate diagnosis from your child's doctor <u>IS NOT</u> an exemption from quarantining. For the health and well-being of our students, staff and Hamburg community, please err on the side of caution.

Potential Pivot to Remote Learning: Due to the above circumstances we must remain aware of the fact that our staff may become symptomatic and also have to quarantine. We may experience staffing shortages on any given day. If this is the case, or our school is required to close for other public health reasons, we may pivot to remote learning on a moment's notice. Please prepare for this scenario with friends, neighbors and family members.
