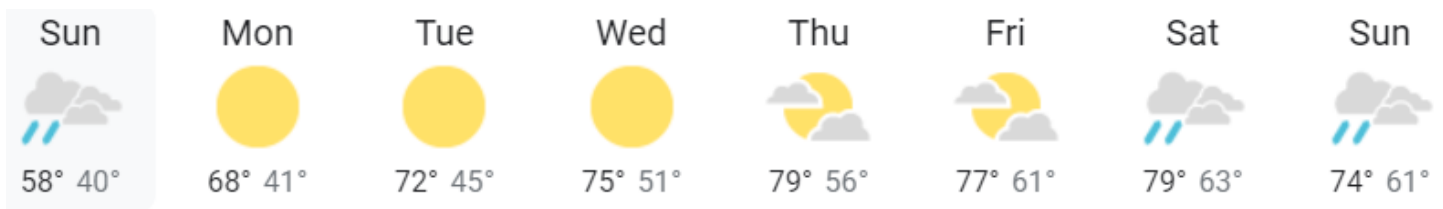
PTA News
