## Instructions:

- 1) Log into your IXL account

- 2) Click “Learning” in the green bar
- 3) Click “Skill Plan” in the white bar
- 4) Scroll to the bottom - click on “NWEA Math Map Growth 6+”
- 5) Click on the Green Bullseye - “Your Personal Plan” - Be sure you see your name for your personal plan.
- 6) **Complete 4 skill lessons in each one of the 4 categories. This will be a total of 16 short assignments. If there are less than 4 skill lessons in a category, click on “I’m ready for more.”**
- 7) **You must attain a minimum Smart Score of 80 on each assignment - higher Smart Scores will earn you a better grade.**
- 8) This will be your first grade of the new school year.
